The global entertainment landscape has been experiencing a dramatic surge in demand for not just non-English content, but original and/or new-to-screen programming.

In particular, the MENA landscape is seeing audiences expressing an increased appetite for Arabic & locally produced programming. There's especially a thirst for fresh original stories to complement long-running monolithic global franchises that have arguably become overly familiar.

Rise Studios, an entertainment company driving investment into content from the Middle East region, has been quick to recognize this shift and has conducted a research report in partnership with Parrot Analytics to explore these trends.

Parrot Analytics, is a data analytics firm specializing in the entertainment industry, that aims to quantify the demand for TV shows, genres and formats.

By understanding the driving forces behind changing content demand, Rise Studios addresses evolving preferences with top-tier programming.

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Growing Demand for Non-English Content

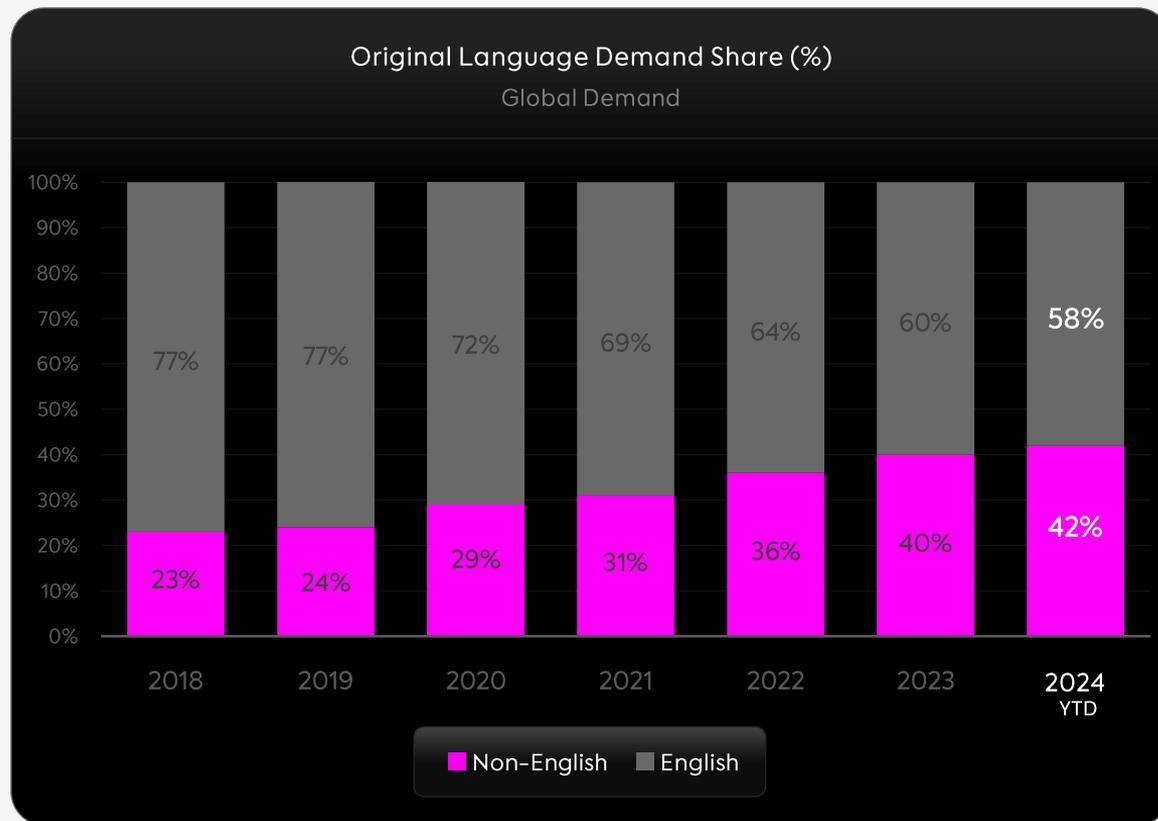


Global demand for non-English content continues to rise...

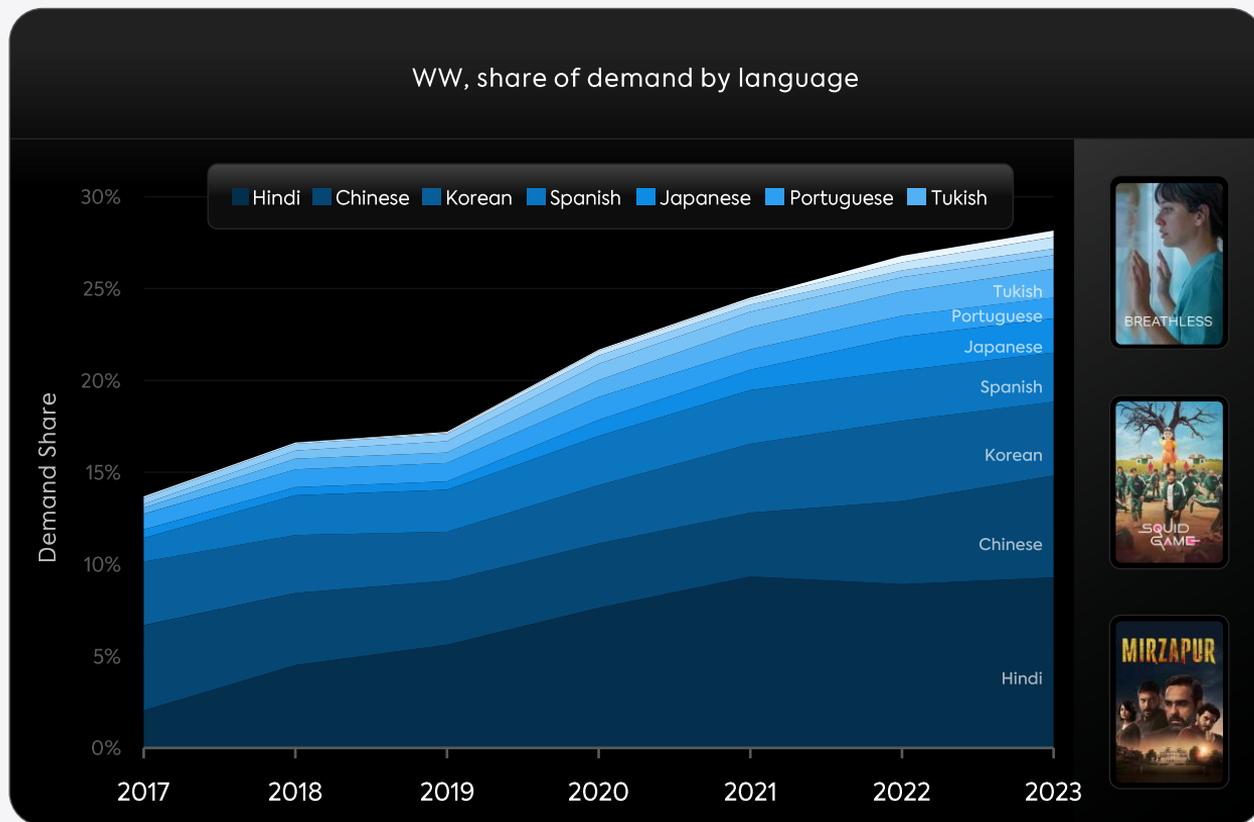
Globally, the demand for non-English content has nearly doubled *since 2018*, now at an all-time high. This is due to greater access supported by worldwide platforms and international production requirements.

Even demand for non-English content in the US has leapt more than +50% over the past three years thanks to improved dubbing, subtitling, and cultural adoption.

Technology is making the world smaller but a viewer's entertainment ecosystem larger, influencing viewer preferences.



Zooming in on the Non-English scripted content trend



Excluding English, the content languages driving the highest global demand are Hindi, Japanese, Korean, Spanish, and Turkish.

South Korea and India now account for 80% of all media spending in Asia (Bloomberg). As India grows as a media hub, it is set to overtake South Korea as Asia's largest media market.

Globally resonant non-English titles are typically original productions, with non-native audiences especially drawn to innovative concepts delivered in familiar formats.

Squid Game: The Catalyst for Korean Drama Growth



All it takes is one local language hit to spur newfound interest in a given region.

The volume of South Korean programming has exploded since *Squid Game* raised the ceiling of global success for non-English content.

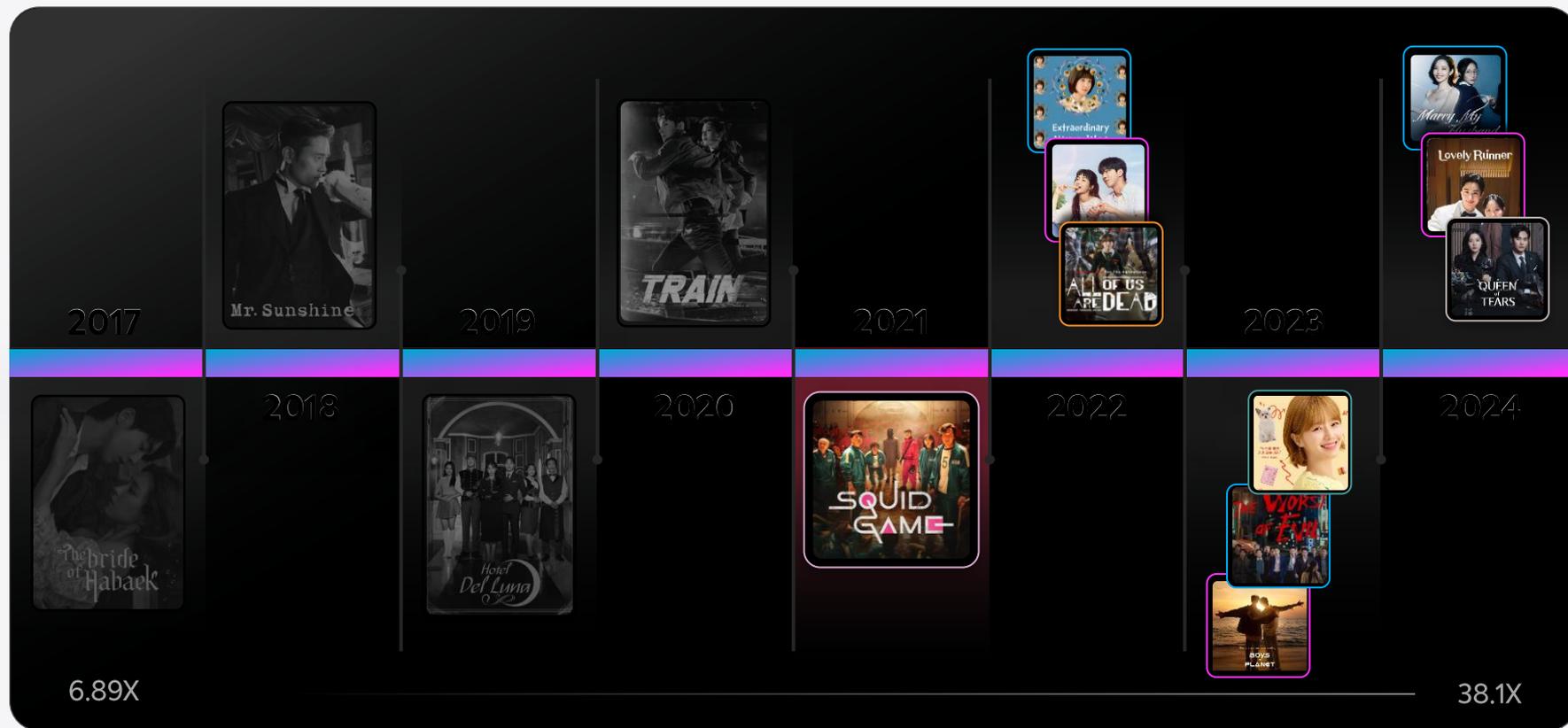
Over 60% of Netflix subscribers have consumed Korean content, per the company (2023). Other platforms are now following the trend.

In May 2023, Apple signed a deal for Korean start-up Kenaz to supply web comics for its Books app, creating a new pipeline of fresh IP for potential on-screen adaptations

Earlier this year, CJ ENM noted that its Korean content success had led to Prime Video “attempting to increase the share of K-content.”

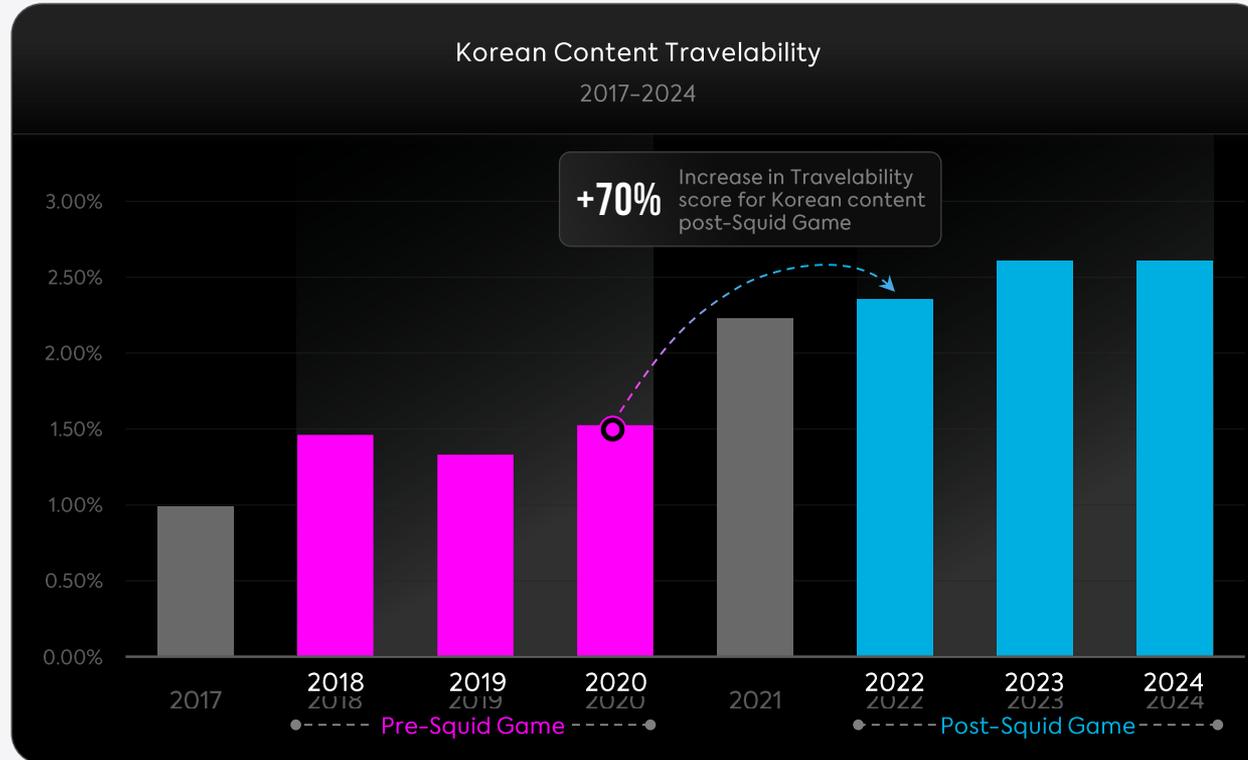




Korean Content's Global Surge:

A 70% Boost in Travelability Post-Squid Game

Most K-Dramas historically only run one season, which may align with Gen Z's preference for shorter-form content.



Audiences with a growing appetite for original storytelling, engaging plots, and compelling characters are increasingly sampling South Korean programming.

Over the past three years, Gen Z has played a significant role in propelling titles like *Lovely Runner*, *The 8 Show*, *All Of Us Are Dead*, and *Queen of Tears* alongside *Squid Game* as the top five Korean originals with the highest global travelability.

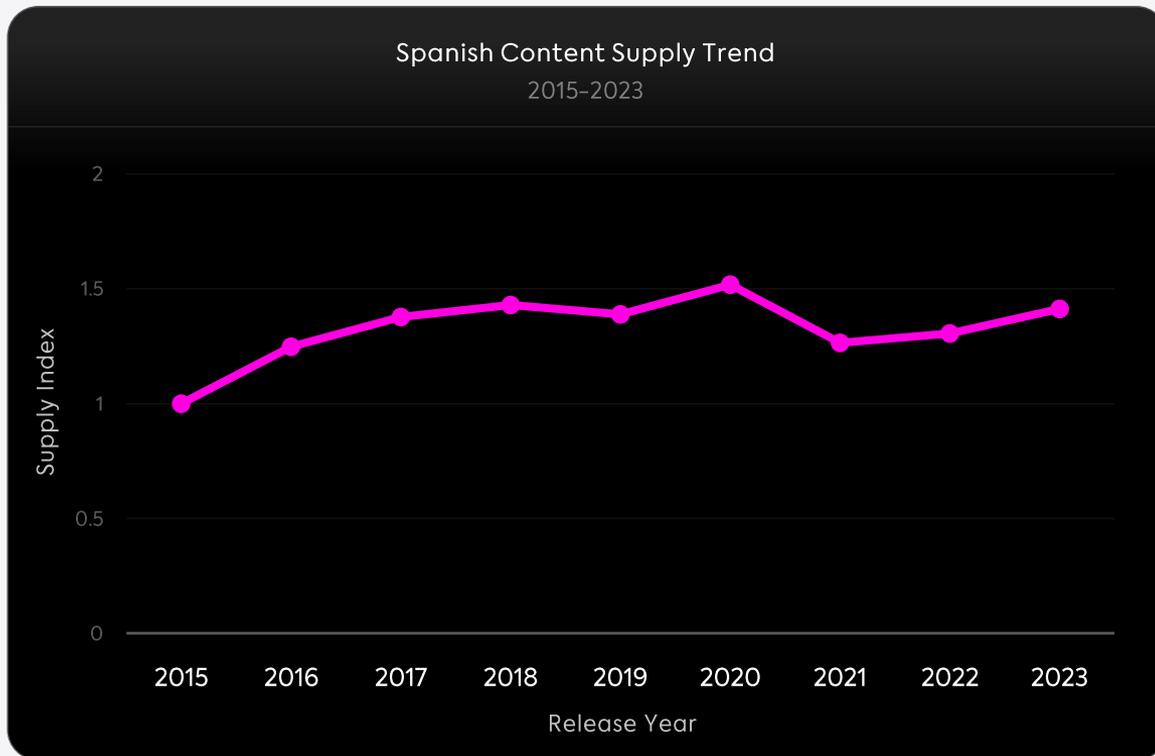

Steady Supply: Spanish-Language Content Continues to Anchor Global Platforms Post-Pandemic

English is not the only globally exportable content language



The supply of Spanish language original programming is steadily recovering from production shutdowns and logjams, presenting an opportunity to program for a truly global viewer base.

Specifically, there are 21 countries that list Spanish as its native language. After Mandarin, Spanish is the world's second most spoken native language.

Major media markets such as Europe, North America and South America boast large populations of Spanish speakers. The language is a necessary content building block for any platforms with global aspirations.

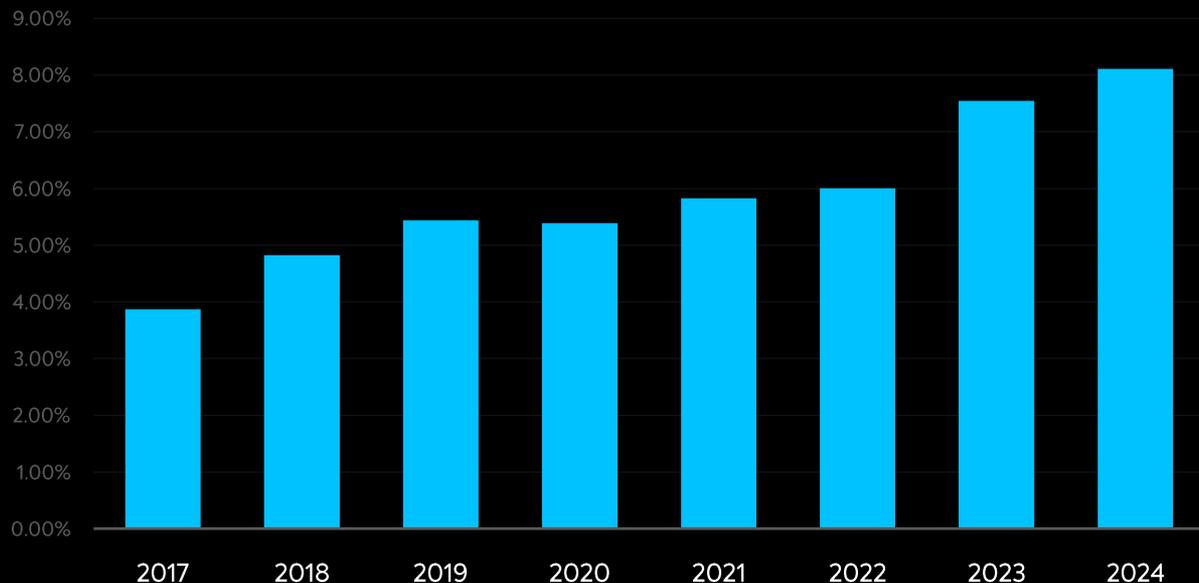




Accelerating Abroad: Spanish Content's Climbing Global Popularity

Spanish-language shows make up only 5% of Netflix's top 18,000 titles but accounts for more than 8% of viewing time (Netflix Engagement Reports).

Netflix sees the opportunity as it spent more than \$200 million on Mexican programming in 2021 and "invested significantly" in Spain (LA Times).

Recognizing the upside, media companies such as TelevisaUnivision, Canela Media, NBCU's Telemundo and Peacock, ESPN+ and Amazon Prime Video have been acquiring Spanish-language sports content in recent years.

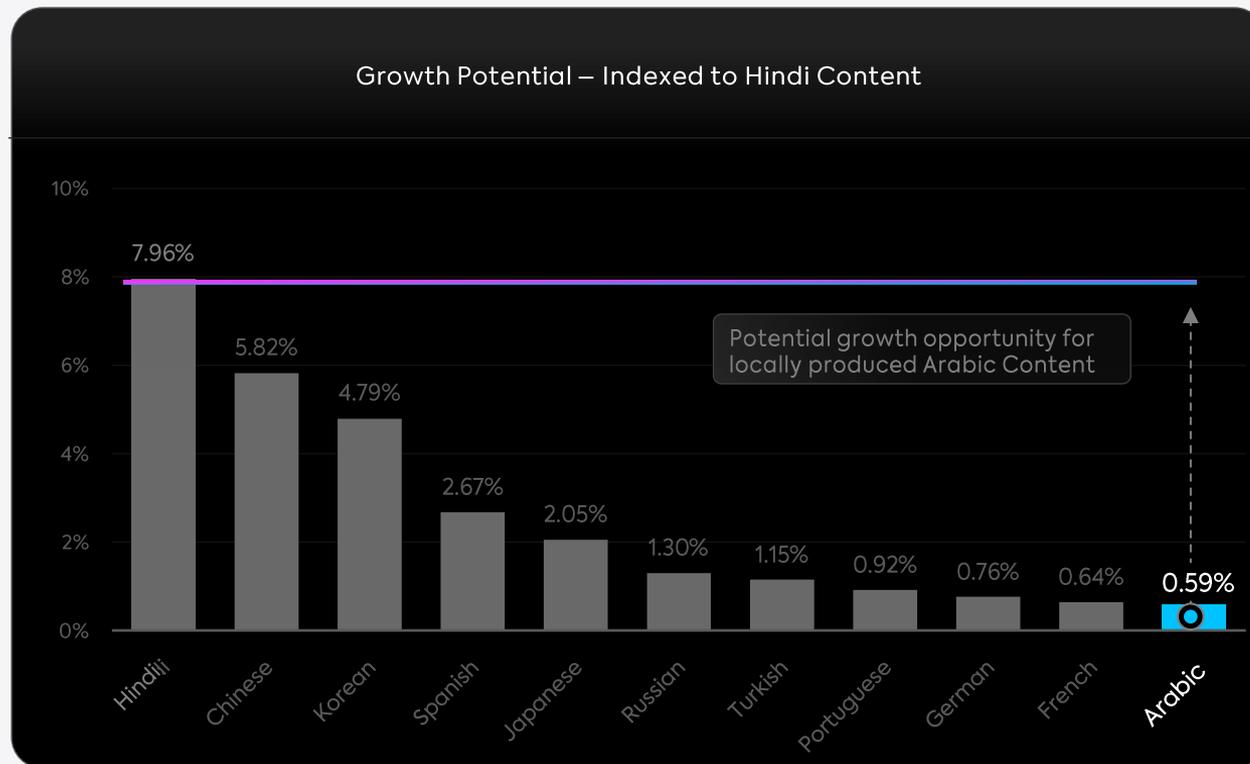

Growth opportunities and expansion ahead



While Arabic content currently lags behind heavyweight Hindi and Chinese content in global growth potential, there is still ample opportunity for ascension.

Platforms that are investing heavily in global content strategies, particularly in the MENA region, stand to benefit from an increase in locally-produced Arabic scripted content that appeals to global audiences.

In terms of worldwide resonance, international viewers have embraced Arabic crime dramas, thrillers, family series and reality competition series coming from the MENA region in 2024.

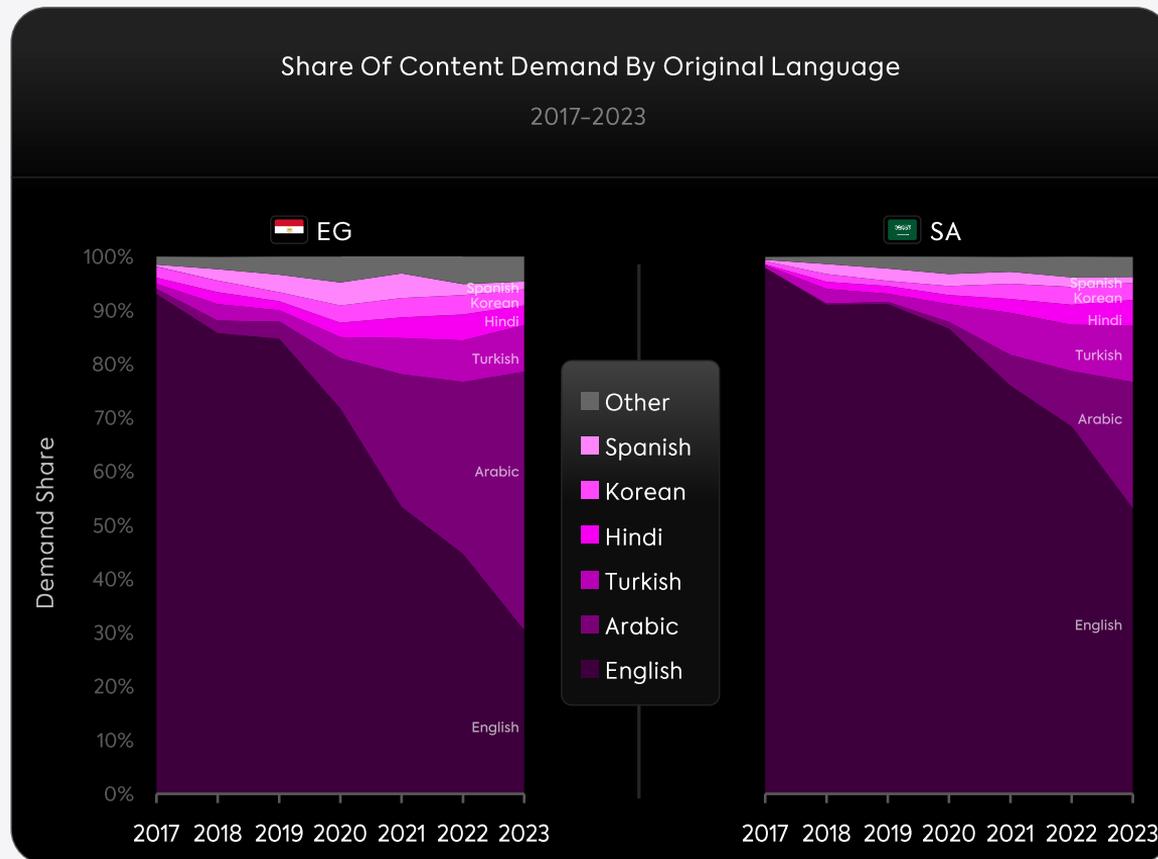
Arabic Content Grows to Meet Increasing Local Demand

Arabic-language content has solidified its dominance in both Egypt and Saudi Arabia, with local demand continuing to rise, particularly since 2020.

The declining demand for international content, like English and Turkish productions, reflects the region's shift towards culturally resonant, locally-produced series and films.

Content ecosystems in Egypt and Saudi Arabia have thrived with the surge in Arabic-language content, now commanding a significant share of total demand.

As platforms expand, the trend toward local Arabic content has become a critical growth strategy, with both regional and global players increasingly investing in original Arabic programming.



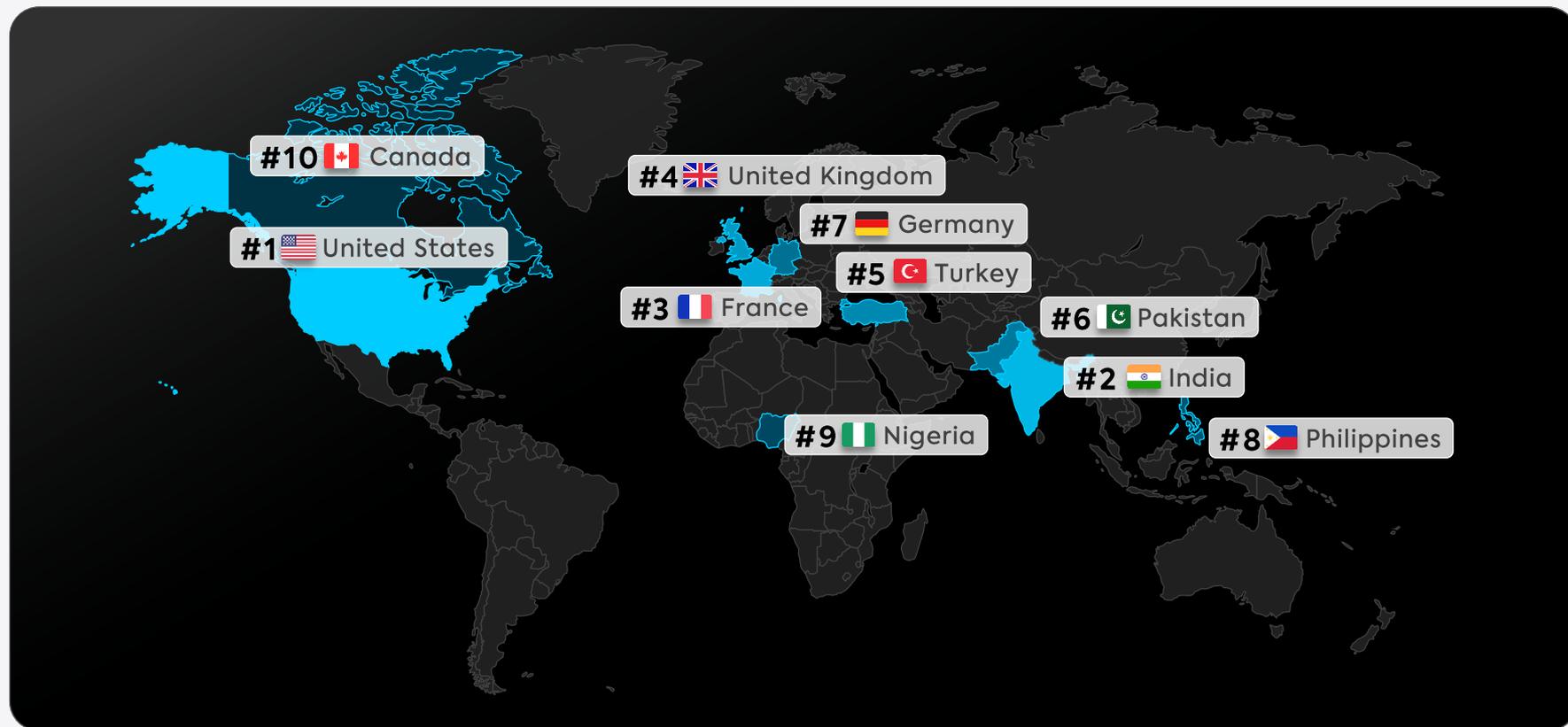
International demand for Arabic content is growing at a very similar rate to regional demand for Arabic content

Indexed to 2020

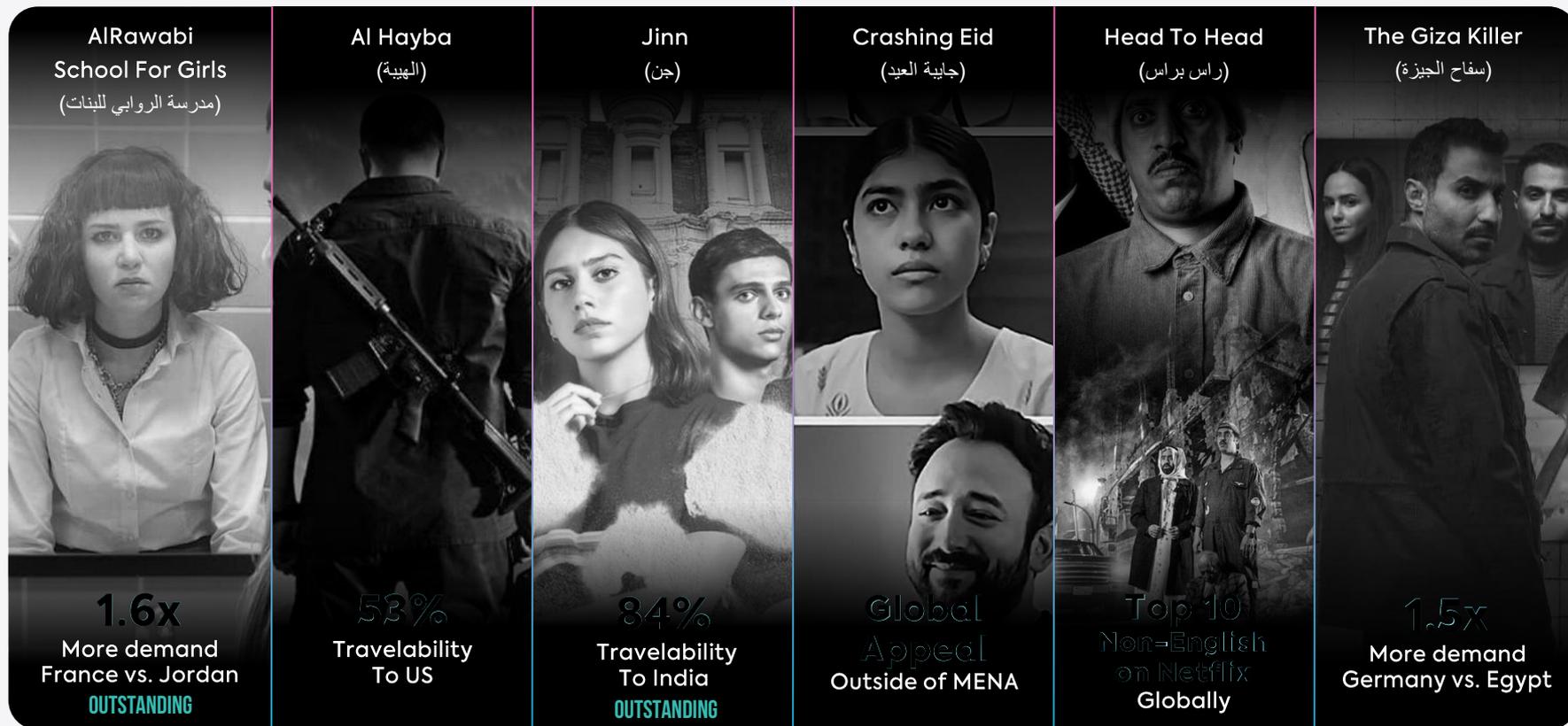
Arabic content is primed for its *"Squid Game"* moment, with the potential for a breakout hit that resonates beyond regional borders.

In the last 30 days, demand in **France** for *AlRawabi School for Girls* has reached 1.6 times the level observed in its home market, Jordan. *AlRawabi School for Girls* hit an all-time global demand peak at 8.96x the average, ranking it among the top 3% of titles globally.

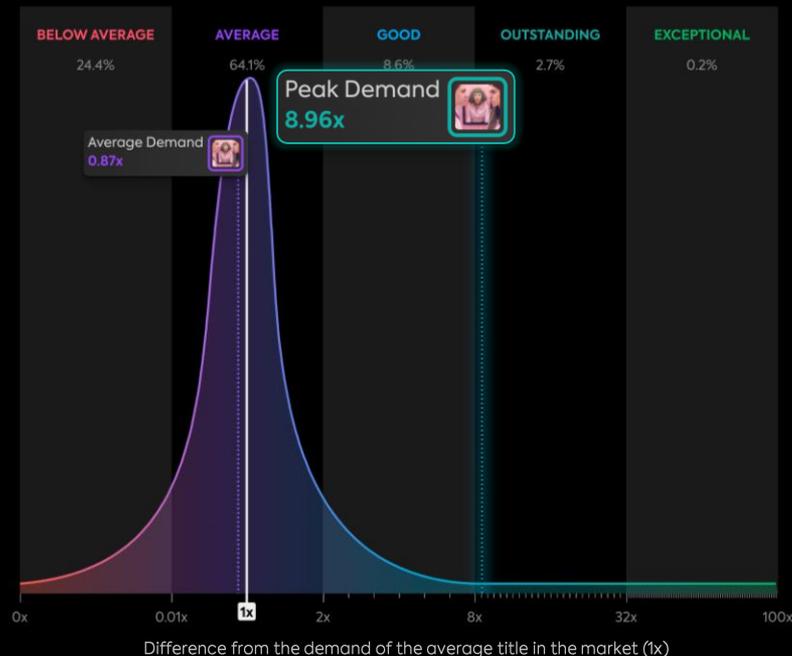

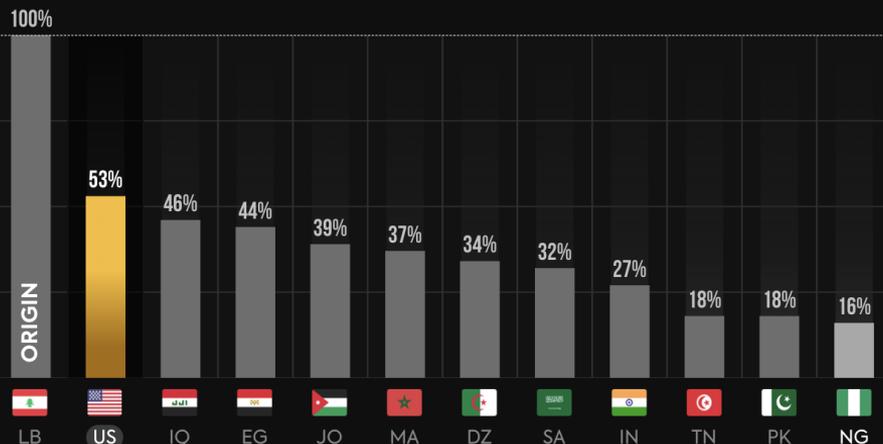
